1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the joint resolu-
3 tion (H.J. Res. 111) providing for congressional dis-
4 approval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code,
5 of the rule submitted by Bureau of Consumer Financial

1 Protection relating to “Arbitration Agreements”. All
2 points of order against consideration of the joint resolu-
3 tion are waived. The joint resolution shall be considered
4 as read. All points of order against provisions in the joint
5 resolution are waived. The previous question shall be con-
6 sidered as ordered on the joint resolution and on any
7 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
8 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
9 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
10 the Committee on Financial Services; and (2) one motion
11 to recommit.
