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# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1119) to establish the bases by which the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall issue, implement, and enforce certain emission limitations and allocations for existing electric utility steam generating units that convert coal refuse into energy, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1917) to allow for judicial review of any final rule addressing national emission standards

for hazardous air pollutants for brick and structural clay products or for clay ceramics manufacturing before requiring compliance with such rule.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 1119) to establish the bases by which the Administrator  
4 of the Environmental Protection Agency shall issue, imple-  
5 ment, and enforce certain emission limitations and alloca-  
6 tions for existing electric utility steam generating units  
7 that convert coal refuse into energy. All points of order  
8 against consideration of the bill are waived. The amend-  
9 ment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the  
10 Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the  
11 bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended,  
12 shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
13 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The pre-  
14 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,  
15 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to  
16 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one  
17 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair  
18 and ranking minority member of the Committee on En-  
19 ergy and Commerce; and (2) one motion to recommit with  
20 or without instructions.

21       SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
22 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 1917)  
23 to allow for judicial review of any final rule addressing

1 national emission standards for hazardous air pollutants  
2 for brick and structural clay products or for clay ceramics  
3 manufacturing before requiring compliance with such rule.  
4 All points of order against consideration of the bill are  
5 waived. An amendment in the nature of a substitute con-  
6 sisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 115-62 shall  
7 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be  
8 considered as read. All points of order against provisions  
9 in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question  
10 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
11 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage  
12 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
13 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
14 minority member of the Committee on Energy and Com-  
15 merce; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without  
16 instructions.

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
