To designate the medical center of the Department of Veterans Affairs in Huntington, West Virginia, as the Hershel “Woody” Williams VA Medical Center.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF HERSHEL “WOODY” WIL-**
4 **LIAMS VA MEDICAL CENTER IN HUNTINGTON,**
5 **WEST VIRGINIA.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The medical center of the De-
7 partment of Veterans Affairs in Huntington, West Vir-
8 ginia, shall after the date of the enactment of this Act

1 be known and designated as the “Hershel ‘Woody’ Wil-
2 liams VA Medical Center”.

3 (b) REFERENCE.—Any reference in any law, regula-
4 tion, map, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the medical center referred to in subsection (a)
6 shall be considered to be a reference to the Hershel
7 “Woody” Williams VA Medical Center.
