To repeal the Klamath Tribe Judgment Fund Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Klamath Tribe Judg-
 5 ment Fund Repeal Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

2 Public Law 89–224 (commonly know as the “Klam-
3 ath Tribe Judgment Fund Act”) (79 Stat. 897) is re-
4 pealed.

5 **SEC. 3. DISBURSEMENT OF REMAINING FUNDS.**

6 *Notwithstanding any provision of Public Law 89–224*
7 *(79 Stat. 897) (as in effect on the day before the date of*
8 *enactment of this Act) relating to the distribution or use*
9 *of funds, as soon as practicable after the date of enactment*
10 *of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall disburse to*
11 *the Klamath Tribe the balance of any funds that, on or be-*
12 *fore the date of enactment of this Act, were appropriated*
13 *or deposited into the trust accounts for remaining legal fees*
14 *and administration and per capita trust accounts, as iden-*
15 *tified by the Secretary of the Interior, under that Act (as*
16 *in effect on the day before the date of enactment of this Act).*

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
