A BILL

To require the Secretary of Defense to implement processes and procedures to provide expedited evaluation and treatment for prenatal surgery under the TRICARE program.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “TRICARE Expedited
5 Evaluation and Treatment for Prenatal Surgery Act of
6 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPEDITED EVALUATION AND TREATMENT FOR**
2 **PRENATAL SURGERY UNDER THE TRICARE**
3 **PROGRAM.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of Defense shall
5 implement processes and procedures to ensure that a cov-
6 ered beneficiary under the TRICARE program whose
7 pregnancy is complicated with a fetal anomaly or sus-
8 pected of being complicated with a fetal anomaly receives,
9 in an expedited manner and at the discretion of the cov-
10 ered beneficiary, evaluation and treatment from a
11 perinatal or pediatric specialist capable of providing sur-
12 gical management and intervention in utero.

13 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section, the terms “cov-
14 ered beneficiary” and “TRICARE program” have the
15 meanings given those terms in section 1072 of title 10,
16 United States Code.

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
