3 **SECTION 1. FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF PAYMENT OF SPE-**
4 **CIAL SURVIVOR INDEMNITY ALLOWANCE**
5 **UNDER SURVIVOR BENEFIT PLAN.**

6 Section 1450(m) of title 10, United States Code, is
7 amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (2)(I), by striking “and 2018”
9 and inserting “through 2023”; and

1 (2) in paragraph (6)—

2 (A) by striking “May 31, 2018” and in-
3 serting “September 30, 2023”; and

4 (B) by striking “June 1, 2018” each place
5 it appears and inserting “October 1, 2023”.

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
