A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to ensure small businesses affected by the onset of transmissible diseases are eligible for disaster relief.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business Relief
5 From Disease Induced Economic Hardship Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3(k)(2) of the Small Busi-
3 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 632(k)(2)) is amended—

4 (1) in subparagraph (B), by striking “and” at
5 the end;

6 (2) in subparagraph (C), striking the period
7 and inserting “; and”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(D) communicable diseases for which the Fed-
10 eral Government issues a travel alert or travel warn-
11 ing.”.

12 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
13 section (a) shall apply to a communicable disease—

14 (1) for which the Federal Government issues a
15 travel alert or travel warning before, on, or after the
16 date of enactment of this Act; and

17 (2) the effects of which are experienced on or
18 after the date of enactment of this Act.
