3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Firearm Act of 2017".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT RE QUIRING RACE OR ETHNICITY TO BE DIS CLOSED IN CONNECTION WITH THE TRANS FER OF A FIREARM.

5 The Federal Government may not require any person
6 to disclose the race or ethnicity of the person in connection
7 with the transfer of a firearm to the person.
