Mr. PETERS (for himself and Mr. RUBIO) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to increase certain funeral benefits for veterans, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Burial Rights for
5 America’s Veterans’ Efforts Act of 2017” or the “BRAVE
6 Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE TO CERTAIN FUNERAL BENEFITS UNDER**
 2 **LAWS ADMINISTERED BY THE SECRETARY OF**
 3 **VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

4 (a) FUNERAL EXPENSES.—Section 2302(a) of title
 5 38, United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in the matter after paragraph (2)(B), by
 7 striking “\$300” and inserting “\$749 (as increased
 8 from time to time under subsection (c))”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
 10 section:

11 “(c) With respect to any fiscal year, the Secretary
 12 shall provide a percentage increase (rounded to the near-
 13 est dollar) in the maximum amount of burial and funeral
 14 expenses payable under subsection (a) equal to the per-
 15 centage by which—

16 “(1) the Consumer Price Index (all items,
 17 United States city average) for the 12-month period
 18 ending on the June 30 preceding the beginning of
 19 the fiscal year for which the increase is made, ex-
 20 ceeds

21 “(2) the Consumer Price Index for the 12-
 22 month period preceding the 12-month period de-
 23 scribed in paragraph (1).”.

24 (b) DEATH FROM SERVICE-CONNECTED DIS-
 25 ABILITY.—Section 2307 of such title is amended—

1 (1) by inserting striking “In any case” and in-
2 serting the following:

3 “(a) IN GENERAL.—In any case”;

4 (2) in subsection (a), as designated by para-
5 graph (1), by striking “\$2,000” and inserting
6 “\$2,000 (as increased from time to time under sub-
7 section (b))”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
9 section:

10 “(b) With respect to any fiscal year, the Secretary
11 shall provide a percentage increase (rounded to the near-
12 est dollar) in the maximum amount of burial and funeral
13 expenses payable under subsection (a) equal to the per-
14 centage by which—

15 “(1) the Consumer Price Index (all items,
16 United States city average) for the 12-month period
17 ending on the June 30 preceding the beginning of
18 the fiscal year for which the increase is made, ex-
19 ceeds

20 “(2) the Consumer Price Index for the 12-
21 month period preceding the 12-month period de-
22 scribed in paragraph (1).”.

23 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
24 this Act shall apply to deaths that occur after the date

1 that is one year after the date of the enactment of this
2 Act.
