A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to reissue the final rules relating to the listing of the gray wolf in the Western Great Lakes and the State of Wyoming under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REISSUANCE OF FINAL RULES RELATING TO**
4 **GRAY WOLVES IN THE WESTERN GREAT**
5 **LAKES AND THE STATE OF WYOMING.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, not later than 60 days after the date of enact-

1 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall re-
2 issue—

3 (1) the final rule entitled “Endangered and
4 Threatened Wildlife and Plants; Revising the Listing
5 of the Gray Wolf (*Canis lupus*) in the Western Great
6 Lakes” (76 Fed. Reg. 81666 (December 28, 2011));
7 and

8 (2) the final rule entitled “Endangered and
9 Threatened Wildlife and Plants; Removal of the
10 Gray Wolf in Wyoming From the Federal List of
11 Endangered and Threatened Wildlife and Removal
12 of the Wyoming Wolf Population’s Status as an Ex-
13 perimental Population” (77 Fed. Reg. 55530 (Sep-
14 tember 10, 2012)).

15 (b) **NO JUDICIAL REVIEW.**—The reissuance of the
16 final rules described in subsection (a) shall not be subject
17 to judicial review.
