Ms. DUCKWORTH (for herself, Mrs. MURRAY, Mr. DURBIN, Mrs. GILLIBRAND, and Mr. CASEY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to provide greater support to students with dependents, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Care Access
5 Means Parents in School Reauthorization Act” or the
6 “CCAMPIS Reauthorization Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO CCAMPIS.**

8 Section 419N of the Higher Education Act of 1965
9 (20 U.S.C. 1070e) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (e)—

2 (A) in paragraph (1), by adding at the end
3 the following:

4 “(C) STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATION.—The
5 Secretary shall work with relevant stakeholders
6 to determine the manner in which the data de-
7 scribed under subparagraph (B) is collected in
8 order to ensure compliance with such subpara-
9 graph.”; and

10 (B) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(3) PUBLICATION OF REPORTS.—Not later
12 than 1 year after the first report is submitted under
13 paragraph (1) after the date of enactment of the
14 CCAMPIS Reauthorization Act, and annually there-
15 after, the Secretary shall publish the reports sub-
16 mitted under paragraph (1) for the preceding year
17 on the public website of the Department.”; and

18 (2) by striking subsection (g) and inserting the
19 following:

20 “(g) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
21 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
22 \$67,000,000 for fiscal year 2018 and each succeeding fis-
23 cal year.”.

1 **SEC. 3. REPORT BY OFFICE OF POSTSECONDARY EDU-**
2 **CATION.**

3 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, the Secretary of Education (acting through
5 the Office of Postsecondary Education) shall report to
6 Congress on the plans of the Department of Education
7 to better serve postsecondary students with dependents.

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
