## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for the designation of State approving agencies for multi-State apprenticeship programs for purposes of the educational assistance programs of the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF STATE APPROVING AGEN-**  
4 **CIES FOR MULTI-STATE APPRENTICESHIP**  
5 **PROGRAMS.**

6 Subsection (c)(1) of section 3672 of title 38, United  
7 States Code, is amended by striking “(1) In the case” and

1 all that follows through “of all such programs.” and in-  
2 serting the following: “(1)(A) The State approving agency  
3 for a multi-State apprenticeship program is—

4 “(i) for purposes of approval of the program,  
5 the State approving agency for the State in which  
6 the headquarters of the apprenticeship program is  
7 located; and

8 “(ii) for all other purposes, the State approving  
9 agency for the State in which the apprenticeship  
10 program takes place.

11 “(B) In this paragraph, the term ‘multi-State ap-  
12 prenticeship program’ means a non-Federal apprentice-  
13 ship program operating in more than one State that meets  
14 the minimum national program standards, as developed  
15 by the Department of Labor.”.
