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## A BILL

To amend the Veterans Access, Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014 to improve the treatment at non-Department of Veterans Affairs facilities of veterans who are victims of military sexual assault, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Sexual Assault  
5 Victims Empowerment Act” or the “Military SAVE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENT OF TREATMENT FOR MILITARY SEX-**  
2 **UAL ASSAULT AT NON-DEPARTMENT OF VET-**  
3 **ERANS AFFAIRS FACILITIES.**

4 Subsection (b)(2) of section 101 of the Veterans Ac-  
5 cess, Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014 (Public Law  
6 113–146; 38 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—

- 7 (1) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking “or”;
- 8 (2) in subparagraph (D)(ii)(II)(dd), by striking  
9 the period at the end and inserting “; or”; and
- 10 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
11 paragraph:

12 “(E) is a victim of a military sexual trau-  
13 ma described in section 1720D(a)(1) of title 38,  
14 United States Code.”.

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
