A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Urban Indian Health
5 Parity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF FULL FEDERAL MEDICAL ASSIST-**
2 **ANCE PERCENTAGE TO URBAN INDIAN ORGA-**
3 **NIZATIONS.**

4 Section 1905(b) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
5 1396d(b)) is amended by striking “Indian Health Care
6 Improvement Act)” and inserting “Indian Health Care
7 Improvement Act) or through an Urban Indian organiza-
8 tion (as defined in section 4 of the Indian Health Care
9 Improvement Act) pursuant to a grant or contract with
10 the Indian Health Service under title V of the Indian
11 Health Care Improvement Act”.

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
