5 Records for Veterans' Ease Act of 2017" or the "SERVE
6 Act of 2017".

# SEC. 2. PROVISION OF MONTHLY HOUSING STIPEND INFOR MATION UNDER POST-9/11 EDUCATIONAL AS SISTANCE PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

5 Section 3313 of title 38, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following new sub7 section:

"(j) PROVISION OF HOUSING STIPEND PAYMENT IN-8 9 FORMATION.—The Secretary shall furnish to individuals receiving educational assistance under this chapter docu-10 mentation that verifies the amount of the monthly housing 11 12 stipend the individual receives under this section. The Secretary shall make such documentation available to the in-13 14 dividual using an internet website in the same manner the 15 Secretary provides documentation verifying compensation 16 and other benefits furnished by the Secretary to individuals.". 17
