## **S. 2349**

### AN ACT

- To direct the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to establish an interagency working group to study Federal efforts to collect data on sexual violence and to make recommendations on the harmonization of such efforts, and for other purposes.
- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **1** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Improve Data on Sex-3 ual Violence Act".

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## 4 SEC. 2. INTERAGENCY WORKING GROUP TO STUDY FED5 ERAL EFFORTS TO COLLECT DATA ON SEX6 UAL VIOLENCE.

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 180 days after 8 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the 9 Office of Management and Budget shall establish an inter-10 agency working group (in this section referred to as the 11 "Working Group") to study Federal efforts to collect data 12 on sexual violence and to make recommendations on the 13 harmonization of such efforts.

(b) COMPOSITION.—The Working Group shall be
comprised of at least one representative from the following
agencies, who shall be selected by the head of that agency:

- 17 (1) The Centers for Disease Control and Pre-18 vention.
- 19 (2) The Department of Defense.
- 20 (3) The Department of Education.
- 21 (4) The Department of Health and Human22 Services.
- 23 (5) The Department of Justice.
- 24 (c) DUTIES.—The Working Group shall consider the25 following:

(1) What activity constitutes different acts of
 sexual violence.

3 (2) Whether reports that use the same terms
4 for acts of sexual violence are collecting the same
5 data on these acts.

6 (3) Whether the context which lead to an act of
7 sexual violence should impact how that act is ac8 counted for in reports.

9 (4) Whether the data collected is presented in
10 a way that allows the general public to understand
11 what acts of sexual violence are included in each
12 measurement.

13 (5) Steps that agencies that compile reports re14 lating to sexual violence can take to avoid double
15 counting incidents of sexual violence.

(d) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 2 years
after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Working
Group shall publish and submit to Congress a report on
the following:

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(1) The activities of the Working Group.

21 (2) Recommendations to harmonize Federal ef22 forts to collect data on sexual violence.

23 (3) Actions Federal agencies can take to imple24 ment the recommendations described in paragraph
25 (2).

(4) Recommendations for congressional action
 to implement the recommendations described in
 paragraph (2).

4 (e) TERMINATION.—The Working Group shall termi5 nate 30 days after the date on which the report is sub6 mitted pursuant to subsection (d).

(f) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

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8 (1) HARMONIZE.—The term "harmonize" in-9 cludes efforts to coordinate sexual violence data col-10 lection to produce complementary information, as 11 appropriate, without compromising programmatic 12 needs.

13 (2) SEXUAL VIOLENCE.—The term "sexual vio14 lence" includes an unwanted sexual act (including
15 both contact and non-contact) about which the Fed16 eral Government collects information.
