Mr. SULLIVAN (for himself and Ms. MURKOWSKI) introduced the following
bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and
Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for the correction of a survey of certain land
in the State of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF FEDERAL LAND WITHIN THE**
4 **SWAN LAKE HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT**
5 **BOUNDARY.**

6 Not later than 18 months after the date of enactment
7 of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior, after consulta-
8 tion with the Secretary of Agriculture, shall—

9 (1) survey the exterior boundaries of the tract
10 of Federal land within the project boundary of the

1 Swan Lake Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2911)
2 as generally depicted and labeled “Lost Creek” on
3 the map entitled “Swan Lake Project Boundary—
4 Lot 2” and dated February 1, 2016; and

5 (2) issue a patent to the State of Alaska for the
6 tract described in paragraph (1) in accordance
7 with—

8 (A) the survey authorized under paragraph
9 (1);

10 (B) section 6(a) of the Act of July 7, 1958
11 (commonly known as the “Alaska Statehood
12 Act”) (48 U.S.C. note prec. 21; Public Law 85–
13 508); and

14 (C) section 24 of the Federal Power Act
15 (16 U.S.C. 818).

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
