## A BILL

To authorize the Society of the First Infantry Division to make modifications to the First Division Monument located on Federal land in President's Park in Washington, DC, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “First Division Monu-  
5 ment Modification Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF FIRST DIVISION MONUMENT.**

7 (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—The Society of the First In-  
8 fantry Division (which is an organization described in sec-

1 tion 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and  
2 exempt from taxation under section 501(a) of that Code),  
3 may make modifications to the First Division Monument  
4 located on Federal land in President’s Park in Wash-  
5 ington, DC, that was set aside for memorial purposes of  
6 the First Infantry Division.

7 (b) INCLUSIONS.—The modifications authorized  
8 under subsection (a) may include the construction of addi-  
9 tional plaques, and the construction of additional stone  
10 plinths on which to place the plaques, to honor the mem-  
11 bers of the First Infantry Division who paid the ultimate  
12 sacrifice during United States operations, including Oper-  
13 ation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom and New  
14 Dawn, and Operation Enduring Freedom.

15 (c) REQUIRED CONSULTATION.—The First Infantry  
16 Division at the Department of the Army shall collaborate  
17 with the Secretary of Defense to provide the list of the  
18 not more than 5,000 names of members of the First In-  
19 fantry Division to be added to the Monument.

20 (d) APPLICATION OF COMMEMORATIVE WORKS  
21 ACT.—Subsections (b) and (c) of section 8903 of title 40,  
22 United States Code (commonly known as the “Commemo-  
23 rative Works Act”), shall not apply to activities authorized  
24 under this section.

1       (e) FUNDING.—Federal funds may not be used to pay  
2 any costs of the activities authorized under this section.
