Ms. CORTEZ MASTO (for herself, Mr. WHITEHOUSE, Ms. KLOBUCHAR, Mr. MARKEY, Mr. UDALL, Ms. WARREN, Mr. BLUMENTHAL, and Mrs. FEINSTEIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To require additional disclosures relating to donations to the Presidential Inaugural Committee, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Inaugural Committee
5 Transparency Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN DONATIONS TO AND**
2 **SPENDING BY THE PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURAL COMMITTEE.**

4 Section 510 of title 36, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b)—

7 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, and
8 disclosing any disbursement made in an amount
9 equal to or greater than \$200 and the purpose
10 of each disbursement”; and

11 (B) in paragraph (2)—

12 (i) in subparagraph (B), by striking
13 “and” at the end;

14 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by striking
15 the period at the end and inserting “;
16 and”; and

17 (iii) by adding at the end the fol-
18 lowing:

19 “(D) for any disbursement in an amount
20 equal to or greater than \$200 that is made, in-
21 cluding any such disbursement made after the
22 end of the inaugural period—

23 “(i) the name and address of the per-
24 son to whom the disbursement was made;

25 “(ii) the date on which the disburse-
26 ment was made; and

1 “(iii) the total amount and purpose of
2 the disbursement.”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(d) REQUIREMENT.—

5 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than the date
6 that is 90 days after the date of the Presidential in-
7 augural ceremony, the committee shall disburse any
8 remaining donated funds.

9 “(2) EXTENSION.—

10 “(A) REQUEST.—Upon request from the
11 Inaugural Committee, the Federal Election
12 Commission may extend the 90-day period de-
13 scribed in paragraph (1).

14 “(B) SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT.—In the
15 case of an extension under subparagraph (A),
16 the Inaugural Committee shall, not later than
17 the last day of the extension period, file a sup-
18 plement to the report required under subsection
19 (b)(1).”.
