## A BILL

To require the Federal Communications Commission to make the provision of Wi-Fi access on school buses eligible for E-rate support.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. E-RATE SUPPORT FOR SCHOOL BUS WI-FI.**

4 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “school  
5 bus” means a passenger motor vehicle that is—

6 (1) designed to carry a driver and not less than  
7 5 passengers; and

8 (2) used significantly to transport early child  
9 education, elementary school, or secondary school

1 students to or from school or an event related to  
2 school.

3 (b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Federal Communica-  
5 tions Commission shall conduct a rulemaking to make the  
6 provision of Wi-Fi access on school buses eligible for sup-  
7 port under the E-rate program of the Commission set  
8 forth under subpart F of part 54 of title 47, Code of Fed-  
9 eral Regulations.
