Mr. YOUNG (for himself and Mr. DONNELLY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To designate the National Airmail Museum at Smith Air Field in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Airmail Mu-
5 seum Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds that—

8 (1) in 1930, commercial airmail carriers began
9 operations at Smith Field in Fort Wayne, Indiana;

1 (2) the United States lacks a national museum
2 dedicated to airmail; and

3 (3) the airmail hangar at Smith Field in Fort
4 Wayne, Indiana—

5 (A) will educate the public on the role of
6 airmail in aviation history; and

7 (B) honor the role of the hangar in the
8 history of the Nation’s airmail service.

9 **SEC. 3. DESIGNATION.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—The airmail museum located at
11 the Smith Field in Fort Wayne, Indiana, is designated as
12 the “National Airmail Museum”.

13 (b) EFFECT OF DESIGNATION.—The national mu-
14 seum designated by this section is not a unit of the Na-
15 tional Park System and the designation of the National
16 Airmail Museum shall not require or permit Federal funds
17 to be expended for any purpose related to that national
18 memorial.

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
