A BILL

For the relief of Vichai Sae Tung (also known as Chai Chaowasaree).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE STATUS FOR VICHAI**
4 **SAE TUNG.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, for purposes of the Immigration and Nation-
7 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Vichai Sae Tung (also
8 known as Chai Chaowasaree) shall be held and considered
9 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
10 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
11 this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

1 (b) REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE
2 VISAS.—Upon the granting of permanent residence to
3 Vichai Sae Tung (also known as Chai Chaowasaree) pur-
4 suant to subsection (a), the Secretary of State shall in-
5 struct the proper officer to reduce by one during the cur-
6 rent or subsequent fiscal year the total number of immi-
7 grant visas available to natives of the country of the alien's
8 birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nation-
9 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
