A BILL

To nullify the effect of the recent Executive order regarding border security and immigration enforcement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESCISSION.**

4 The provisions of Executive Order 13767 (82 Fed.
5 Reg. 8793; January 25, 2017), entitled “Border Security
6 and Immigration Enforcement Improvements”, are re-
7 scinded and shall not have any legal effect.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 This Act shall take effect as if enacted on January
3 25, 2017.

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
