## A BILL

To reauthorize the National Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Providing Resources,  
5       Officers, and Technology To Eradicate Cyber Threats to  
6       Our Children Act of 2017” or the “PROTECT Our Chil-  
7       dren Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE NATIONAL INTERNET**  
2 **CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE**  
3 **PROGRAM.**

4 Title I of the PROTECT Our Children Act of 2008  
5 (42 U.S.C. 17601 et seq.) is amended—

6 (1) in section 105(h) (42 U.S.C. 17615(h)), by  
7 striking “2016” and inserting “2022”; and

8 (2) in section 107(a)(10) (42 U.S.C.  
9 17617(a)(10)), by striking “fiscal year 2018” and  
10 inserting “each of fiscal years 2018 through 2022”.
