AN ACT

To facilitate construction of a bridge on certain property in Christian County, Missouri, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. RIVERSIDE BRIDGE PROJECT.

2	(a) In General.—The Riverside Bridge Project is
3	authorized to be carried out notwithstanding—
4	(1) any agreement entered unto under, or re-
5	striction pursuant to, section 404(b)(2) of the Rob-
6	ert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency As-
7	sistance Act (42 U.S.C. $5170c(b)(2)$); or
8	(2) any easement or other Federal restriction
9	pursuant to that Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.) that
10	requires the covered property to be maintained for
11	open space, recreation, or wetland management.
12	(b) Conditions.—As a condition of the authoriza-
13	tion under subsection (a)—
14	(1) Christian County, Missouri, or an assignee
15	shall—
16	(A) carry out the Riverside Bridge Project
17	in a manner that ensures that no flood damage
18	attributable to the Project occurs; and
19	(B) be liable for any such flood damage
20	that does occur; and
21	(2) the Federal Government shall not be liable
22	for future flood damage that is caused by the
23	Project.
24	(c) DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROHIBITED.—No future
25	disaster assistance from any Federal source may be pro-

1	vided with respect to the covered property or any improve-
2	ments thereon.
3	(d) Definitions.—In this Act, the following defini-
4	tions apply:
5	(1) COVERED PROPERTY.—The term "covered
6	property" means the property—
7	(A) in Christian County, Missouri;
8	(B) conveyed to such County by the River-
9	side Inn, Inc.; and
10	(C) that is approximately 1.5 acres and
11	482 lineal feet adjacent to the westerly line of
12	Riverside Road to the center of Finley Creek.
13	(2) RIVERSIDE BRIDGE PROJECT.—The term
14	"Riverside Bridge Project" means the project to
15	construct, maintain, and operate a bridge on and
16	over the covered property.
