A BILL

To require notice of cost-free Federal procurement technical assistance in connection with registration of small business concerns in procurement systems.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Procurement Fraud
5 Prevention Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NOTICE OF COST-FREE FEDERAL PROCUREMENT**
2 **TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IN CONNECTION**
3 **WITH REGISTRATION OF SMALL BUSINESS**
4 **CONCERNS IN PROCUREMENT SYSTEMS.**

5 The Administrator of General Services, in consulta-
6 tion with the Director of the Office of Management and
7 Budget, shall establish procedures to ensure that any no-
8 tice or direct communication regarding registration of a
9 small business concern in a procurement system contains
10 information about cost-free Federal procurement technical
11 assistance services that are available through the Small
12 Business Administration, Procurement Technical Assist-
13 ance Centers of the Defense Logistics Agency, the Depart-
14 ment of Commerce (including the Minority Business De-
15 velopment Agency), and other Federal agencies and pro-
16 grams.
