## A BILL

To amend the Tariff Act of 1930 to protect personally identifiable information, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Moving Americans Pri-  
5 vacy Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE IN-**  
7 **FORMATION.**

8 Paragraph (2) of section 431(c) of the Tariff Act of  
9 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1431(c)(2)) is amended to read as fol-  
10 lows:

1       “(2)(A) The information listed in paragraph (1) shall  
2 not be available for public disclosure if—

3               “(i) the Secretary of the Treasury makes an af-  
4 firmative finding on a shipment-by-shipment basis  
5 that disclosure is likely to pose a threat of personal  
6 injury or property damage; or

7               “(ii) the information is exempt under the provi-  
8 sions of section 552(b)(1) of title 5 of the United  
9 States Code.

10       “(B) The Commissioner of U.S. Customs and Border  
11 Protection shall ensure that any personally identifiable in-  
12 formation, including social security numbers, passport  
13 numbers, and residential addresses, are removed from any  
14 manifest signed, produced, delivered, or transmitted under  
15 this section before the manifest is disclosed to the public.”.
