JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Georgia of Javelin Missiles and Javelin Command Launch Units.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a letter of offer with respect to any
4 of the following proposed sales to the Government of Geor-
5 gia (described in the certification Transmittal No. 17–59,
6 sent to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and
7 the chairman of the Committee on Foreign Relations of
8 the Senate pursuant to section 36(b)(1) of the Arms Ex-

1 port Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1)) on February 17,
2 2017, is hereby prohibited:

3 (1) The proposed sale of four hundred and ten
4 (410) Javelin Missiles and related equipment and
5 support (Transmittal Numbered 17–59).

6 (2) The proposed sale of seventy-two (72) Jav-
7 elin Command Launch Units (CLUs) and related
8 equipment and support (Transmittal Numbered 17–
9 59).

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
