RESOLUTION

To authorize document production by the Select Committee
on Intelligence in *United States v. Paul J. Manafort,
Jr.* (D.D.C.)

Whereas, the prosecution in *United States v. Paul J.
Manafort, Jr.*, Cr. No. 17–201, currently pending in the
United States District Court for the District of Colum-
bia, has requested a copy of a transcript of an interview
of W. Samuel Patten conducted by the Select Committee
on Intelligence;

Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States
and Rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evi-
dence under the control or in the possession of the Sen-
ate can, by administrative or judicial process, be taken
from such control or possession but by permission of the
Senate;

Whereas, when it appears that documents, papers, and records under the control or in the possession of the Senate may promote the administration of justice, the Senate will take such action as will promote the ends of justice consistent with the privileges of the Senate: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman of
2 the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, acting joint-
3 ly, are authorized to provide to the prosecution in *United*
4 *States v. Paul J. Manafort, Jr.*, under appropriate security
5 procedures, a copy of the transcript of the Committee's
6 interview of W. Samuel Patten and exhibits referenced in
7 the interview.
