Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require that the Supreme Court of the United States be composed of nine justices.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein),*

4 That the following article is proposed as an amend-
5 ment to the Constitution of the United States, which shall
6 be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Con-
7 stitution when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths
8 of the several States within seven years after the date of
9 its submission for ratification:
