## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require legislative approval for certain regulations.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 9 for ratification:

1	"ARTICLE —
2	"Section 1. If one-fourth of the total membership
3	of the House of Representatives or one-fourth of the total
4	membership of the Senate sign a petition disapproving of
5	any proposed department or agency regulation, the Clerk
6	of the House or the Secretary of the Senate shall transmit
7	such petition to the President. The proposed regulation
8	subject to the petition shall not have force or effect until

- 9 and unless a joint resolution approving such proposed reg-
- 10 ulation and not containing any other matter is agreed to
- 11 by each body of the Congress by a recorded vote and is
- 12 enacted.
- "Section 2. The Congress shall have the power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation.".
