- 3 Section 2302(b)(8)(B) of title 5, United States Code,
- 4 is amended by striking "or to the Inspector" and all that
- 5 follows through "such disclosures" and inserting "the In-
- 6 spector General of an agency, a supervisor in the employ-
- 7 ee's direct chain of command up to and including the head
- 8 of the employing agency, or to an employee designated by
- 9 any of the aforementioned individuals for the purpose of
- 10 receiving such disclosures".

### 11 SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 13 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 14 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 15 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 16 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 17 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
- 18 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 19 vote on passage.
