A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1 SECTION 1. REPORT ON EFFECTS OF GUN VIOLENCE ON

- 2 **PUBLIC HEALTH.**
- 3 Not later than one year after the date of the enact-
- 4 ment of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Surgeon
- 5 General of the Public Health Service shall submit to Con-
- 6 gress a report on the effects on public health of gun vio-
- 7 lence in the United States during the relevant period, and
- 8 the status of actions taken to address such effects.
