3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rescinding DHS’
5 Waiver Authority for Border Wall Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF WAIVER AUTHORITY FOR THE CON-**
7 **STRUCTION OF NEW BORDER BARRIERS.**

9 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (division C of Pub-
10 lic Law 104–208; 8 U.S.C. 1103 note) is amended by
