## A BILL

To repeal the Environmental Protection Agency's most recent rule for new residential wood heaters.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Stop EPA Overregula-  
5        tion of Rural Americans Act”.

6        **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RULE FOR NEW RESIDENTIAL WOOD**  
7        **HEATERS.**

8        The final rule entitled “Standards of Performance for  
9        New Residential Wood Heaters, New Residential Hydronic  
10       Heaters and Forced-Air Furnaces” published at 80 Fed.

- 1 Reg. 13672 (March 16, 2015) shall have no force or effect
- 2 and shall be treated as if such rule had never been issued.
