A BILL

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to reauthorize certain programs relating to nonpoint source management, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Local Water Protection
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NONPOINT SOURCE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.**

7 Section 319(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control
8 Act (33 U.S.C. 1329(j)) is amended by striking “sub-
9 sections (h) and (i) not to exceed” and all that follows
10 through “fiscal year 1991” and inserting “subsections (h)
11 and (i) \$200,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020
12 through 2024”.
