A BILL

To amend the Mineral Leasing Act to create a buffer in between oil and gas drilling operations and homes, businesses, schools, and other buildings that require special protection, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Drilling in Our
5 Backyards Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. BUFFER FROM OIL AND GAS DRILLING OPER-**
2 **ATIONS.**

3 The Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 181 et seq.) is
4 amended by—

5 (1) redesignating section 44 as section 45; and

6 (2) inserting after section 44 the following:

7 **“SEC. 45. BUFFER FROM OIL AND GAS DRILLING OPER-**
8 **ATIONS.**

9 “The Secretary of the Interior may not issue a permit
10 for any oil and gas drilling operation that is located within
11 1,500 feet from a home, business, school, or other building
12 that requires special protection, as determined by the Sec-
13 retary.”.
