#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Grizzly Bear State
- 5 Management Act of 2019".

# SEC. 2. REISSUANCE OF FINAL RULE RELATING TO GREAT ER YELLOWSTONE ECOSYSTEM POPULATION OF GRIZZLY BEARS.

4 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall reissue the final rule relating to removing the Greater Yellowstone 6 7 Ecosystem population of grizzly bears from the Federal 8 List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife, published on June 30, 2017 (82 Fed. Reg. 30502), without regard to 9 10 any other provision of statute or regulation that applies to issuance of such rule. Such reissuance (including this 11 section) shall not be subject to judicial review. 12
