A BILL

To amend title IV of the Social Security Act to target funds to truly needy families.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Focusing State Efforts
- 5 to Expand Opportunity Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. TARGETING FUNDS TO TRULY NEEDY FAMILIES.
- 7 Section 404(k) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- $8 \quad 604(k)$) is amended to read as follows:
- 9 "(k) Prohibitions.—A State to which a grant is
- 10 made under this part shall not use the grant to provide

- 1 any assistance or services to a family whose monthly in-
- 2 come exceeds twice the poverty line (as defined by the Of-
- 3 fice of Management and Budget, and revised annually in
- 4 accordance with section 673(2) of the Omnibus Budget
- 5 Reconciliation Act of 1981 (42 U.S.C. 9902(2))).".
