## A BILL

To update the map of, and modify the maximum acreage available for inclusion in, the Yucca House National Monument.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Yucca House National
- 5 Monument Boundary Revision Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. YUCCA HOUSE NATIONAL MONUMENT AMEND-
- 7 MENTS.
- 8 (a) BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.—The boundaries of
- 9 Yucca House National Monument are revised to include
- 10 the approximately 160 acres of land generally depicted as

- 1 "Proposed Expansion Tract" on the map entitled "Yucca
- 2 House National Monument Proposed Boundary Revision",
- 3 numbered 318/105,085, and dated August 2010.
- 4 (b) Map.—The map referred to in subsection (a)
- 5 shall be on file and available for public inspection in ap-
- 6 propriate offices of the National Park Service of the De-
- 7 partment of the Interior.
- 8 (c) ACQUISITION.—Within the lands described in sub-
- 9 section (a), the Secretary of the Interior may acquire lands
- 10 and interests in lands by donation. The Secretary of the
- 11 Interior may pay administrative costs of such donations
- 12 with appropriated funds.
