3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gun Manufacturers
5 Accountability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF PROHIBITION ON BRINGING QUALIFIED**
2 **CIVIL LIABILITY ACTIONS IN FEDERAL OR**
3 **STATE COURT.**

4 Sections 2 through 4 of the Protection of Lawful
5 Commerce in Arms Act (15 U.S.C. 7901–7903; Public
6 Law 109–92) are hereby repealed.

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
