To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish a school security coordinating council, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Coordinating and
- 3 Leveraging Activities for School Security Act" or the
- 4 "CLASS Act of 2019".

5 SEC. 2. SCHOOL SECURITY COORDINATING COUNCIL.

- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title VII of the Homeland Secu-
- 7 rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 341 et seq.) is amended by
- 8 adding at the end the following new section:

9 "SEC. 711. SCHOOL SECURITY COORDINATING COUNCIL.

- 10 "(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the
- 11 Department a coordinating council to ensure that, to the
- 12 maximum extent practicable, activities, plans, and policies
- 13 to enhance the security of an early childhood education
- 14 program, elementary school, high school, or secondary
- 15 schools against an act of terrorism are coordinated.
- 16 "(b) Composition.—The members of the council es-
- 17 tablished pursuant to subsection (a) shall include the fol-
- 18 lowing:
- "(1) The Under Secretary for Strategy, Policy,
- and Plans.
- 21 "(2) The Director of the Cybersecurity and In-
- 22 frastructure Security.
- 23 "(3) The Administrator of the Federal Emer-
- 24 gency Management Agency.
- 25 "(4) The Director of the Secret Service.

- 1 "(5) The Executive Director of the Office of
- 2 Academic Engagement.
- 3 "(6) The Assistant Secretary for Public Affairs.
- 4 "(7) Any other official of the Department the
- 5 Secretary determines appropriate.
- 6 "(c) Leadership.—The Secretary shall designate a
- 7 member of the council to serve as chair of the council.
- 8 "(d) Reports.—Not later than January 30, 2021,
- 9 and annually thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to the
- 10 Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Rep-
- 11 resentatives and the Committee on Homeland Security
- 12 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a report regard-
- 13 ing the council's activities during the preceding year, in-
- 14 cluding information on any metrics regarding the efficacy
- 15 of such activities and any engagement with stakeholders
- 16 outside of the Federal Government.
- 17 "(e) Definitions.—In this section, the terms 'early
- 18 childhood education program', 'elementary school', 'high
- 19 school', and 'secondary school' have the meanings given
- 20 such terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Sec-
- 21 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).".
- 22 (b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of contents
- 23 in section 1(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is

- 1 amended by inserting after the item relating to section
- 2 710 the following new item:

"Sec. 711. School security coordinating council.".
