3 SECTION 1. E-RATE SUPPORT FOR SCHOOL BUS WI-FI.

- 4 (a) RULEMAKING.—
- 5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the 7 Commission shall commence a rulemaking to make 8 the provision of Wi-Fi access on school buses eligible 9 for support under the E-rate program of the Com-

3	(2) ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS.—Notwithstanding
4	section $254(h)(1)(B)$ of the Communications Act of

6	shall provide in the rulemaking under paragraph (1)
7	for State educational agencies, educational service
8	agencies, and local educational agencies to be eligible
9	to receive the support described in such paragraph.

11	(1) COMMISSION.—The term "Commission"
12	means the Federal Communications Commission.
13	(2) School bus.—The term "school bus"
14	means a passenger motor vehicle that is—
15	(A) designed to carry a driver and not less
16	than 5 passengers; and
17	(B) used significantly to transport—
18	(i) children enrolled in an early child-
19	hood education program to or from such
20	program or an event related to such pro-
21	gram; or
22	(ii) students enrolled in an elementary
23	school or secondary school to or from such
24	school or an event related to such school.

1 (3) TERMS DEFINED IN ELEMENTARY AND SEC-2 ONDARY EDUCATION ACT OF 1965.—The terms "early childhood education program", "educational 3 service agency", "elementary school", "local edu-4 cational agency", "secondary school", and "State 5 educational agency" have the meanings given such 6 terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Sec-7 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801). 8
