Mr. GOMEZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To require notice from the Secretary of the Treasury in the case of any closure of a Taxpayer Assistance Center.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NOTICE FROM IRS REGARDING CLOSURE OF**
4 **TAXPAYER ASSISTANCE CENTERS.**

5 Not later than 90 days before the date that a pro-
6 posed closure of a Taxpayer Assistance Center would take
7 effect, the Secretary of the Treasury, or the Secretary's
8 delegate, shall—

9 (1) make publicly available (including by non-
10 electronic means) a notice which—

1 (A) identifies the Taxpayer Assistance
2 Center proposed for closure and the date of
3 such proposed closure; and

4 (B) identifies the relevant alternative
5 sources of taxpayer assistance which may be
6 utilized by taxpayers affected by such proposed
7 closure; and

8 (2) submit to Congress a written report that in-
9 cludes the information included in the notice de-
10 scribed in paragraph (1), the reasons for such pro-
11 posed closure, and such other information as the
12 Secretary may determine appropriate.
