**AN ACT**

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the Intelligence Rotational Assignment Program in the Department of Homeland Security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DHS Intelligence Ro-  
5 tational Assignment Program Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-**  
2 **GRAM.**

3 Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002  
4 (6 U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
5 lowing new subsection:

6 “(b) INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-  
7 GRAM.—

8 “(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 1 year  
9 after the date of the enactment of this section, the  
10 Secretary shall establish an Intelligence Rotational  
11 Assignment Program as part of the Rotation Pro-  
12 gram under subsection (a).

13 “(2) ADMINISTRATION.—The Chief Human  
14 Capital Officer, in conjunction with the Chief Intel-  
15 ligence Officer, shall administer the Intelligence Ro-  
16 tational Assignment Program established pursuant  
17 to paragraph (1).

18 “(3) ELIGIBILITY.—The Intelligence Rotational  
19 Assignment Program shall be open to employees  
20 serving in existing analyst positions within the De-  
21 partment’s Intelligence Enterprise and other Depart-  
22 ment employees as determined appropriate by the  
23 Chief Human Capital Officer and the Chief Intel-  
24 ligence Officer.

25 “(4) COORDINATION.—The responsibilities  
26 specified in paragraph (3)(B) of subsection (a) that

1 apply to the Rotation Program under such sub-  
2 section shall, as applicable, also apply to the Intel-  
3 ligence Rotational Assignment Program under this  
4 subsection.”.

5 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

6 *This Act may be cited as the “DHS Intelligence Rota-*  
7 *tional Assignment Program Act of 2019”.*

8 **SEC. 2. INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-**  
9 **GRAM.**

10 *Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6*  
11 *U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the following:*

12 *“(b) INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-*  
13 *GRAM.—*

14 *“(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 1 year*  
15 *after the date of enactment of this subsection, the Sec-*  
16 *retary shall establish an Intelligence Rotational As-*  
17 *signment Program as part of the Rotation Program*  
18 *under subsection (a).*

19 *“(2) ELIGIBILITY.—The Intelligence Rotational*  
20 *Assignment Program shall be open to employees serv-*  
21 *ing in analyst positions in an intelligence component*  
22 *of the Department, analyst positions in the United*  
23 *States Secret Service, and other positions in the De-*  
24 *partment, as determined appropriate by the Sec-*  
25 *retary.*

1           “(3) *COORDINATION.*—*The Chief Human Capital*  
2           *Officer shall carry out the responsibilities relating to*  
3           *the Rotation Program that are specified in subsection*  
4           *(a)(3)(B) with respect to the Intelligence Rotational*  
5           *Assignment Program under this subsection, to the ex-*  
6           *tent those responsibilities are applicable to the Intel-*  
7           *ligence Rotational Assignment Program.*”.
