A BILL

To reauthorize and extend funding for community health
centers and the National Health Service Corps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Health In-
5 vestment, Modernization, and Excellence Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY HEALTH**
7 **CENTERS AND NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE**
8 **CORPS.**

9 Section 10503 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
10 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 254b–2) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b)(1)—

2 (A) in subparagraph (E), by striking
3 “and” at the end;

4 (B) in subparagraph (F), by striking the
5 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

6 (C) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(G) for fiscal year 2020, \$4,200,000,000;

8 “(H) for fiscal year 2021, \$4,400,000,000;

9 “(I) for fiscal year 2022, \$4,600,000,000;

10 “(J) for fiscal year 2023, \$4,800,000,000;

11 and

12 “(K) for fiscal year 2024,
13 \$5,000,000,000.”; and

14 (2) in subsection (b)(2)—

15 (A) in subparagraph (E), by striking
16 “and” at the end;

17 (B) in subparagraph (F), by striking the
18 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

19 (C) by adding at the end the following:

20 “(G) \$325,000,000 for fiscal year 2020;

21 “(H) \$340,000,000 for fiscal year 2021;

22 “(I) \$355,000,000 for fiscal year 2022;

23 “(J) \$370,000,000 for fiscal year 2023;

24 and

“(K) \$385,000,000 for fiscal year 2024.”.
