3 **SECTION 1. USE OF POSTAL SERVICE HARD COPY CHANGE**

4 **OF ADDRESS FORM TO REMIND INDIVIDUALS**

5 **TO UPDATE VOTER REGISTRATION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the

7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Postmaster General

1 shall modify any hard copy change of address form used
2 by the United States Postal Service so that such form con-
3 tains a reminder that any individual using such form
4 should update the individual's voter registration as a re-
5 sult of any change in address.

6 (b) APPLICATION.—The requirement in subsection
7 (a) shall not apply to any electronic version of a change
8 of address form used by the United States Postal Service.
