A BILL

To regulate lobbying by Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fannie Mae and
5 Freddie Mac Lobbying Regulation Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON LOBBYING ACTIVITY BY FANNIE**
7 **MAE AND FREDDIE MAC.**

8 Part 3 of subtitle A of the Federal Housing Enter-
9 prises Financial Safety and Soundness Act of 1992 (12

1 U.S.C. 4601 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
2 the following new section:

3 **“SEC. 1357. LIMITATIONS ON LOBBYING ACTIVITY BY EN-**
4 **TERPRISES.**

5 “During any period in which an enterprise is in con-
6 servatorship or receivership pursuant to section 1367,
7 such enterprise may not engage in any activity that would
8 result in such enterprise being a client for purposes of sec-
9 tion 3(2) of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 (2
10 U.S.C. 1602(2)).”.
