Mr. SEAN PATRICK MALONEY of New York (for himself, Mr. FITZPATRICK, and Mr. GALLAGHER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To improve the ability of separating or retiring members of the Armed Forces to seek services provided by county veterans service officers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Know Your Vets Act”.

5 SEC. 2. INFORMATION REGARDING COUNTY VETERANS

6 SERVICE OFFICERS.

7 (a) PROVISION OF INFORMATION.—The Secretary of
8 Defense shall ensure that a member of the Armed Forces
9 who is separating or retiring from the Armed Forces may

1 elect to have the Department of Defense form DD-214
2 of the member transmitted to the appropriate county veterans
3 service officer based on the mailing address provided
4 by the member.

5 (b) DATABASE.—The Secretary of Defense, in coordination
6 with the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, shall maintain
7 a database of all county veterans service officers.

8 (c) COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE OFFICER DEFINED.—In this section, the term “county veterans service
9 officer” means an employee of a county government, local
10 government, or Tribal government who is covered by section
11 14.629(a)(2) of title 38, Code of Federal Regulations.
