A BILL

To provide that human life shall be deemed to begin with fertilization.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Sanctity of Human5 Life Act".

6 SEC. 2. DECLARATION.

7 In the exercise of the powers of the Congress, includ8 ing Congress' power under article I, section 8 of the Con9 stitution, to make necessary and proper laws, and Con-

gress' power under section 5 of the 14th article of amend ment to the Constitution of the United States—

3 (1) the Congress declares that—

4 (A) the right to life guaranteed by the 5 Constitution is vested in each human being, and 6 is the paramount and most fundamental right 7 of a person; and

8 (B) the life of each human being begins 9 with fertilization, cloning, or its functional 10 equivalent, irrespective of sex, health, function 11 or disability, defect, stage of biological develop-12 ment, or condition of dependency, at which time 13 every human being shall have all the legal and 14 attributes constitutional and privileges of 15 personhood; and

16 (2) the Congress affirms that the Congress,
17 each State, the District of Columbia, and all United
18 States territories have the authority to protect the
19 lives of all human beings residing in its respective
20 jurisdictions.

21 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.

22 For purposes of this Act:

(1) FERTILIZATION.—The term "fertilization"
means the process of a human spermatozoan penetrating the cell membrane of a human oocyte to cre-

1	ate a human zygote, a one-celled human embryo,
2	which is a new unique human being.
3	(2) CLONING.—The term "cloning" means the
4	process called somatic cell nuclear transfer, that
5	combines an enucleated egg and the nucleus of a so-
6	matic cell to make a human embryo.
7	(3) HUMAN; HUMAN BEING.—The terms
8	"human" and "human being" include each and
9	every member of the species homo sapiens at all
9 10	every member of the species homo sapiens at all stages of life, beginning with the earliest stage of de-
